

Updated Visitor Policy

Patient Safety is our top priority. There is a measles outbreak in New York. To protect patients, we made a temporary change to our visitor policy.



Here are some ways we can partner to keep you and your family safe from measles:

- Visitors who have a fever, cough or rash should not visit any patients.
- Visitation to inpatient units and procedural units in the hospital is limited to immunized individuals over 5 years old. Children younger than age 5 will need to have proof of immunity.
- Visitors to the NICU will be limited to parents and grandparents. Parents and grandparents who live in zip codes where the measles outbreak is occurring will need to show proof of immunity prior to entering the NICU.
- Visitors who live in zip codes where a measles outbreak is occurring will need to provide proof of immunity when visiting immunocompromised patients.
